#### A. Approve December 8, 2014 Meeting Minutes.

#### **Additional Discussion Item**

Fire districts and representation of fire districts on the ACCEM Executive Council was discussed. For emergency management purposes and grant allocation considerations, fire districts are treated as departments/offices of the city they serve. The same holds true for law enforcement or any other entity that provides a service to the city (sewer district, water district, etc.).

Primary points of consideration:

- 1. Should fire districts have representation on the ACCEM Executive Council? One district, all districts, dues paying?
- 2. Or, does the current fire district relationship (treated as part of the city) need to be more formally codified in ACCEM policy or Joint Powers Agreement? Or can it be codified in a memorandum of understanding between the fire district and city?

Mayor Evans asked Councilman Stear, as both a Kuna City Councilman and a Kuna Rural Fire District Commissioner, to research the subject in a little more detail and report back to the ACCEM Executive Council.
