- **Plan Update Overview**

- **Training and Exercise Opportunities**  
Joe Lombardo gave an update on the future training and exercise opportunities available, including multi-hazard planning for schools. This update included a PowerPoint presentation.
- **Stop the Bleed**  
Chris Shandera, Ada County Paramedic, shared information on Stop the Bleed training available through the Ada County Paramedics. This training looks to improve various organizations emergency preparedness by training personnel to stop uncontrolled bleeding. If anyone wishes to bring this training to their organization he is willing to assist.
