

The following is the Asbestos Receiving Procedure for the Ada County Solid Waste Management. This procedure applies to all asbestos containing waste entering the Ada County Landfill.

- I. CONTAINERIZATION
  - A. Asbestos waste must be double bagged (each bag a minimum of 6 mil thickness).
  - B. Bags must be permanently marked with an appropriate warning label approved by OSHA or US EPA.
  - C. Asbestos containing material that cannot be placed in bags must be wrapped in transparent, double 6 mil thickness plastic. All seams must be sealed to prevent fiber release.
  - D. OSHA or US EPA warning labels must be permanently attached to inner plastic wrap for asbestos waste material in Item C.
  - E. Waste Shipment Records (WSR) must accompany the asbestos waste.
- II. DISPOSAL
  - A. Properly containerized asbestos waste can be accepted 8:30 A.M. to 3:00 P.M., Monday through Friday at the Ada County Landfill.
  - B. Contractor/Hauler must give the Ada County Solid Waste Management Department (208-577-4725) at least one business day notice prior to arrival at the landfill site.
  - C. Containerized asbestos waste loads arriving prior to scheduled disposal time may be required to wait until scheduled time before disposal is permitted.
  - D. Containerized asbestos waste loads arriving after scheduled disposal time may be refused entry into the landfill.
  - E. Containerized asbestos waste loads will be inspected by a staff member of the Ada County Solid Waste Management Department or Hazardous Waste Screener before or during off-loading. Improper or damaged containers may result in the load being rejected for disposal.
  - F. Hauler shall post an advisory sign near the transport vehicle stating that asbestos waste is being unloaded while the asbestos containing waste load is being off loaded.
  - G. The Contractor/Hauler will stack or place containerized asbestos waste as directed by the inspecting staff member.
  - H. The Contractor/Hauler will provide necessary manpower and equipment at the time of delivery to stack or place the containerized waste.
  - I. Waste containing asbestos that is being generated/removed from outside of Ada County are not acceptable for disposal at the landfill site.

## III. FEES

Fees charged for asbestos waste are based on incoming measured volume. The Board of Ada County Commissioners sets landfill fees. The current rate is \$50.00 per cubic yard with a \$50.00 minimum. (The minimum \$50.00 charge includes the price for disposal certificate.)
