# ADA COUNTY LANDFILL: Hidden Hollow Cap: Stage 2

### **OVERVIEW**

Ada County has managed the County's municipal solid waste at the landfill since 1972. Most of the waste has been buried in the original cell known as Hidden Hollow. In recent years, the County underwent a major project to design, permit, and excavate a new cell, called the North Ravine cell (or NRC). The highly engineered, fully lined NRC provides a long-term solution for solid waste disposal in Ada County.

With the Hidden Hollow cell near capacity, and the daily placement of trash occurring in NRC, the process began to install a cap on Hidden Hollow. About half of the Hidden Hollow cell was capped in 2004. This second phase caps another large portion of the cell. The work involved using heavy equipment to place a final thick layer of soil on the landfill and then planting native vegetation to blend in with the natural surrounding landscape.
