

ADA COUNTY BARBER PARK EVENT CENTER

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Ada County's crown jewel, Barber Park, is traditionally the starting point for over 125,000 Boise river tubers and rafters each summer. In addition to being used as a launching site, the park is a popular wildlife-watching spot with natural areas for bald eagles, waterfowl, and other creatures.

In 2007, a new convertible indoor/outdoor facility was added to provide rentable event space for weddings, private parties and other events.

- Rentable facility with catering/staging area to accommodate food service

- Dividable space allows facility to be used for up to four separate events
- Indoor seating for up to 249 people, outdoor seating for 192 people



ENVIRONMENTAL BENEFITS

- Exterior walls can slide open to provide natural ventilation and full access to the outdoors
- Reduced energy requirements through use of natural daylighting design techniques
- Use of natural and low emitting materials to provide a healthy indoor environment
- Minimized impact on the site by replanting of removed trees on a 3 to 1 ratio
