## IV. Recyclable Material Marketing Update – Dave Dean

Dave provided the SWAC subcommittee an excellent overview in regards to China's upcoming restrictive policy regarding the importation of recyclables. This policy (National Sword) will, if implemented without modification, significantly impact local and national recycling efforts.

China is the largest consumer of recyclable materials exported from the United States. A huge portion of recyclable material collected in western US states is exported to China. The remainder of US states are not as dependent on China as the final destination for collected recyclable materials. Under National Sword, China has stated that it will ban, effective January 1, 2018, 24 materials from being imported including mixed plastic and mixed paper. Additionally, China announced that the quantity of contaminants or "prohibitives" that will be accepted in any imported recyclable material cannot exceed 0.3% of the recyclable material total weight (less than 5 ounces in 100 pounds).

These limitations have created serious commodity price reductions. Until and unless China modifies National Sword's stated limitations and prohibitions, commodity prices will probably remain depressed.

Recycling firms and public entities are actively looking for other outlets for collected recyclables. To date, long term and financially attractive "other" markets for high volume mixed recyclables have not been located.

V. Communitywide curbside Recycling Update – Rachele Klein Topic IV was discussed until meeting adjournment. Topic V was neither presented nor discussed.
