KUNA PROPERTY CRIME INVESTIGATIONS



Kuna residents reported 232 property crimes in 2010 which included 67 vandalisms, 34 vehicle burglaries and 25 home burglaries. Nationally, clearance rates for property crimes are generally 18 – 20%. In Idaho, 22% of property crimes were cleared in 2009. Kuna Police have a substantially higher clearance rate – solving more than 30% of property crimes in 2008, 2009 and again in 2010.

Several members of the Kuna Police Department were honored for their role in solving dozens of burglaries around Ada County. Using information gathered about commercial burglaries reported in the area, crime analysts were able to predict where and when a business would likely be targeted next. Deputies and detectives focused patrols on those areas. In January 2010, a quick response to a burglary alarm in Kuna allowed investigators to identify a suspect vehicle. After a traffic stop and several interviews, detectives were able to arrest a suspect and solve about 50 commercial burglaries committed in Ada County.
