## 2012 HIGHLIGHTS

- Increased enforcement of aggressive driving and DUI through grants from the Idaho Transportation Department and Office of Traffic Safety to reduce unsafe driving in our community.
- Instructed a semester-long leadership course at Initial Point High School and hosted a job-shadow program for Kuna High. Students received credit while learning about law enforcement, crime prevention and public safety.
- Created a Kuna Police Activities League so Kuna youth would have the opportunity to participate in safe and enjoyable activities.
- Expanded office hours and added a fulltime office manager to provide better public service.

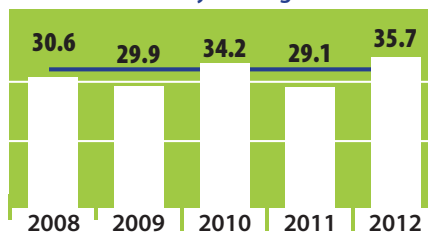


## MESSAGE FROM CHIEF ALDRICH

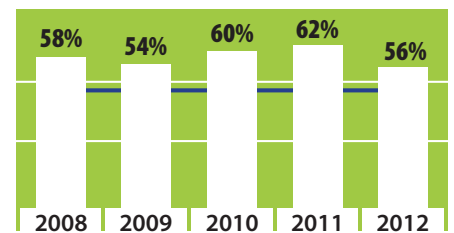
Kuna Police are constantly looking for innovative ways to proactively and effectively address crime in our community. In the last two years, we added a drug detection K-9 and a School Resource Officer for Kuna elementary schools at no cost to the City, thanks to our partnerships with the Ada County Sheriff's Office and Kuna School District. These positions allow us to quickly respond to possible drug activity and focus more attention on abuse and sexual assault investigations, especially when children are being victimized. We appreciate all you do to help us make Kuna a safe place to live, work and play. Together we can make a difference.

## RAPID RESPONSE

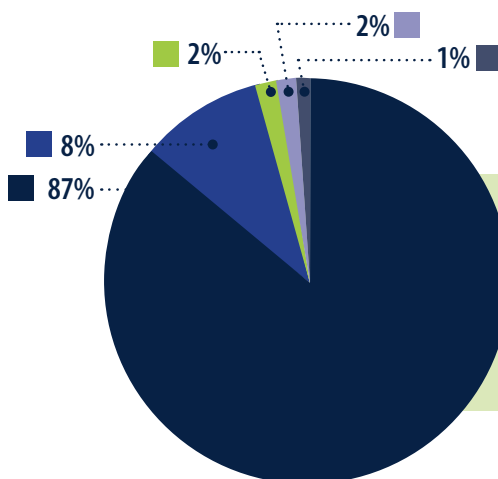


On average, Kuna deputies took 3 minutes and 8 seconds to respond to high-priority emergency calls.
